• INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING / SUBMITTING AN ABSTRACT

1. Preparing the Abstract Submission Form

- a. Abstracts must be typewritten on the submission form.
- b. Prepare two copies of the submission form
 - At the top of the first form type the title of your presentation, each author's last name and initials, and the name of the institution at which the work was done.
 - The second abstract form should be identical to the first form with the following exception; the author's names and the institution should not be listed on the second form.
- c. For each category of abstracts, the content must follow the sequence outlined below. The sequence headings should be written in bold in the abstract.

2. Submitting the Abstract Form

- a. Two copies of your abstract form (one with and one without identifying information) may be submitted by mail **or** email. Abstracts must be received by **Friday, August 20, 2010**

3. Evaluation / Selection and Notification

- a. All abstracts are reviewed using a masked review by selected members of the Chapter Research Committee.
- b. There is an option for submitters to indicate preference for type of presentation (poster or platform) and to indicate whether or not you are willing to present in either format.
- c. Notification of acceptance for presentation will be sent via e-mail (or phone) to the contact person listed on the abstract form by September 8, 2010
