“Current Best Evidence Update for the Management of Selected Hip Disorders”

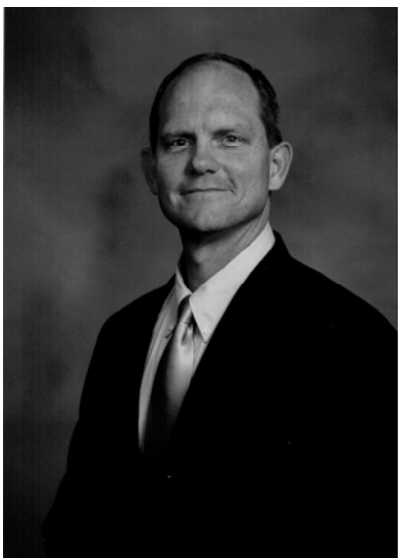
COURSE OBJECTIVES:

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

1. List key anatomical and biomechanical considerations in managing patients with hip disorders.
2. Summarize the evidence for key clinical tests and measures and components of a systematic manual examination and intervention approach for patients with hip disorders.
3. Summarize the evidence for management of hip osteoarthritis and other musculoskeletal disorders associated with the hip region, with emphasis on manual therapy and exercise interventions.
4. Summarize evidence-based home exercise programs considerations for patients with hip disorders, hip OA in particular, that reinforces clinical interventions to maximize patient outcomes.
5. Discuss surgical considerations for common hip disorders and implications for rehabilitation.
6. Given a patient case, discuss key critical thinking and clinical reasoning considerations.

COURSE INSTRUCTOR:

Robert S. Wainner, PT, PhD



Dr. Wainner is currently Associate Professor at Texas State University Program in Physical Therapy, where he directs and teaches the Orthopaedic Curriculum. He is a Partner and VP of Clinical Excellence of Texas Physical Therapy Specialists, P.C. a therapist owned and operated practice dedicated to providing evidence-based care to patients with musculoskeletal disorders and co-founder and Partner in Evidence-In-Motion, a company dedicated to promotion and advancement of evidence-based physical therapy practice and translating evidence into practice. He currently is Director of the EIM Orthopaedic Physical Therapy Residency Program. Dr. Wainner earned his Ph.D. in Rehabilitation Science from the University of Pittsburgh in 2000, his M.S. in Physical Therapy from the University of Kentucky in 1992 and BS in Physical Therapy from The University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston in 1985. He is internationally recognized by both clinical and scientific communities for his expertise and is a frequent research presenter at state and national meetings on the topics of advanced clinical examination techniques, evidence-based practice and manual physical therapy. He has published over 35 manuscripts in

leading peer-reviewed journals and is the author of 2 educational CD-ROMs on Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapy. He has been an author and investigator on projects that have received some of the professions most prestigious research awards, including the Steven J. Rose Excellence in Research Award, the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapists (AAOMPT) Excellence in Research Award, and the International Federation of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapists (IFOMPT) Excellence in Research Award. Dr. Wainner received the Texas Physical Therapy Association's 2004 Texas Physical Therapy Researcher of the Year Award, was inducted into the Military Order of Medical Merit, is a two-time recipient of the Air Force Physical Therapist of the Year Award and received the 2009 Practice Award of the APTA Private Practice. He is currently an Editorial Review Board Member for the Journal of Orthopaedic and Sports Physical Therapy and a reviewer for Physical Therapy.
